

USCIS finally using more secure mail delivery service

After many years of sending important documents by regular mail and with no tracking, U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) will finally change its ways. The agency has started phasing in the use of the U.S. Postal Service's Signature Confirmation Restricted Delivery service. During the first phase, which began on April 30, 2018, USCIS will re-mail documents that were returned to USCIS as non-deliverable. These documents include Permanent Resident Cards ("green cards") and Employment Authorization Documents. Eventually, USCIS will mail all secure documents using the Postal Service's Signature Confirmation service.
